CLAIM CODES

This enhanced service is for the treatment of patients who require complex injections as part of their ongoing treatment plans. *This template covers the administering of the vaccine and diary entries for invites.*

- at risk of osteoporotic fracture who require Denosumab injections

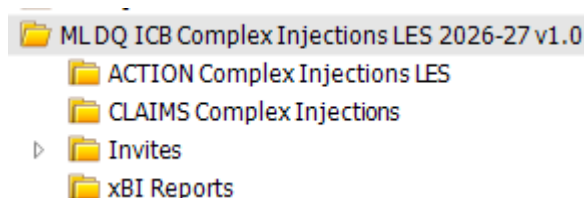

All the searches work on the assumption that relevant codes have been added to the patients record from the template 'ML ICB Local Enhanced Services'.

DENDQ1 Identifies patients who have been prescribed denosumab in the last 12 months, but do not have a diary entry on their record

for recall purposes, using the code **700139004** |Denosumab therapy (procedure)|. Without a diary entry, these patients may not be invited for a review. If you are using your own recalls this search can be ignored. **ACTION**: Review and add diary code, if relevant.

DENDQ2 Identifies patients who have received a prescription for denosumab in the claim period but no claim code added. **ACTION**: Review and add claim code, if relevant.

DENDQ3 Identifies patients with accurate coding that has been entered on the wrong consultation type. For Complex Injections, this should be a face to face or home visit consultation. **ACTION**: If you find any activity in the Action/Check Consultation Type searches that should count towards claims, add a new consultation to the patient's record (on the same date as the excluded one) using an acceptable consultation type of **Face to Face Consultation** and the correct claim code (see above). This keeps the original consultation unchanged and ensures the patient appears in the claims searches.

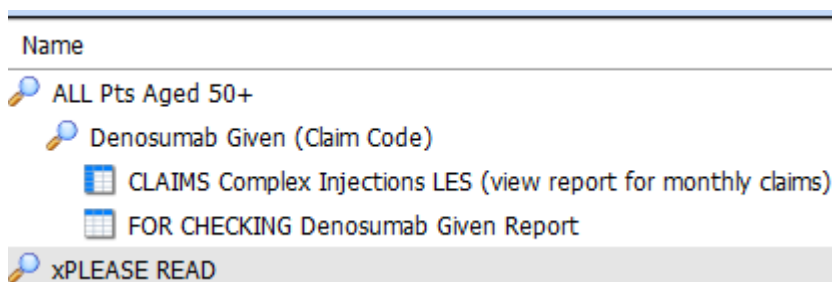
Claim code

700139004 Denosumab therapy

Claims searches are based on left/deceased patients with the claim code above being added to the patient's record, within the specified timeframe. Searches are based on a face to face or home visit consultation type. Searches can be found in the ACTION folder for those who do not have an acceptable consultation type.

These searches identify the number of patients with the appropriate claim code added to the patient's record.

As a patient can receive more than one injection within the financial year, we have created a report labelled CLAIMS which provides you with the number of injections by month. You need to view results of this report to be able to see the breakdown by month. **This will be the information that is provided for payment.** A list report FOR CHECKING is available to show you which patients are included in the claims. This report should be checked for errors. **It is the responsibility of the practice to check through the patients lists to ensure they are claiming appropriately and any duplicates are removed. The DQ Team are not responsible for any incorrect claims made using these searches.**

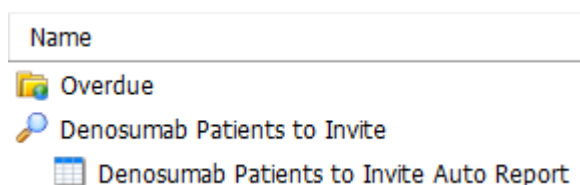


Invites

You may wish to use your own recalls system. If that is the case, then these searches can be ignored.

These searches use the diary entry codes in the Template and Action searches.

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700139004 |Denosumab therapy (procedure)

Run the searches using the date period the patients are due their injection for invitation into the clinic. The same searches are provided in the overdue folder by entering dates for previous months to search for diary entries that are not in the future.
