All the searches work on the assumption that relevant codes have been added to the patients record from the template 'ML ICB Local Enhanced Services'.

Action folder:

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- ECGDQ1 ECG NO claim code on same day
 - ECGDQ1 ECG NO claim code Report
 - ECGDQ2 ECG coded on the same day as another
 - ECGDQ2 ECG coded on the same day as another
 - ECGDQ3 ECG claim codes, CHECK consultations codes

ECGDQ1 – This search identifies patients that may have had an ECG but not had the Enhanced services administration code added at the same date of the ECG. This could be correct if the patient has NOT had the ECG in practice and it is therefore NOT claimable. However, it gives you the option to check that those that should be claimed for are not missed.

ECGDQ2 – Identifies patients who have had more than 1 ECG coded on the same day. As per the spec Where two ECG procedure codes are entered on the same day, payment will be made for one procedure only.

ECGDQ3 – as the claim search has consultation types applied activity must be recorded using the appropriate consultation type, you can use the report to check activity.

Claims folder:

This search identifies how many patients have had the appropriate coding added from the template for a ECG. There are 2 reports, 1 is aggregate and looks at a breakdown for ECG coding number for patients. The 2nd report is a detailed breakdown of activity for ECG LES.
