Prostate-specific antigen monitoring

Claims searches are based on left/deceased patients with the claim code above being added to the patient's record, within the specified timeframe. Searches are based on a face to face or home visit consultation type.

This search identifies how many patients have had the appropriate coding added from the template for a PSA monitoring and the report identifies other appropriate coding elements including PSA level, Urology

Referral and or discharge, PSA threshold for referral and if a future diary date has been added for the patients to help identify any missing information. **REMEMBER** The claim code and template are **ONLY** to be used for those patients requiring follow up in Primary Care and **NOT** for patients requesting ad hoc PSA testing.

**It is the responsibility of the practice to check through the patients lists to ensure they are claiming appropriately and any duplicates are removed. The DQ Team are not responsible for any incorrect claims made using these searches.**
